

**AERMONT FOUNDER LEON BRESSLER TO BECOME GROUP CHAIRMAN  
PAUL GOLDING NAMED MANAGING PARTNER**

**Luxembourg, 7 March 2023** - Aermont Capital today announced that founder Léon Bressler, who has led the group as managing partner since inception in 2007, is to become chairman and that longstanding partner Paul Golding will be named managing partner, effective 3 April 2023.

A leading European real estate business, Aermont is recognised for its operator-oriented approach, focusing on large complex investments that offer long-term value creation opportunities for the associated assets and businesses.

Nathan Shike and Alison Trewartha, also longstanding partners, will continue to play key roles in managing Aermont alongside Paul as they have done for some 15 years. Vincent Rouget will be leaving the business.

Aermont also announced the promotion to partner of Samuel Kreber, CFO, and Henning Richter, managing director, who have made significant positive contributions during their nine years with the business.

Léon Bressler, chairman designate, said "Aermont is going from strength to strength. 2022 was an outstanding year in terms of project completions, investment performance and fundraising. I am proud of those achievements and how they reflect our strong culture and exceptional team, which form the foundation of our vision for the future. I am confident that Paul will succeed in leading Aermont into that future, with the support of partners and colleagues. With the right leadership and organisation, we will continue delivering an excellent performance to the benefit of all stakeholders."
